Sec. 4-3-1 Recreation Board Activation.

There is hereby activated in the city, the public body corporate and politic known as the City of Wrens Recreational Board which was created upon the adoption and approval of O. C. G. A. § 36-64-1 et seq. as amended.

Sec. 4-3-2 Recreation Board Membership: terms: vacancies.

The board shall be composed of nine (9) members who shall serve for five (5) year staggered terms of office. Each of the persons named as initial board members shall serve in such capacity and for the number of years set opposite their respective names by the mayor and council and if, at the end of any term of office of any of the board members, a successor thereto shall not have been elected, then the board member whose term of office shall have expired shall continue to hold office until his successor shall be so elected. However, if a board member fails to attend three (3) consecutive regular meetings of the board without providing the chairperson thereof with good and sufficient excuse, he shall be conclusively deemed to have resigned his post and the mayor and council, by resolution, may declare the post vacant and elect a successor.

Sec. 4-3-3 Recreation Board Powers, duties: generally.

The board members shall organize themselves, carry out their duties and responsibilities and exercise their powers and prerogatives in accordance with the terms and provisions of the recreational authority law as it now exists and as it might hereafter be amended or modified.

Sec. 4-3-4 Recreation Board Organization; staff.

The board may organize itself, adopt by-laws, elect officers, and do any and all other acts consistent with Georgia law; however, the appointment of any managerial or executive employee shall be subject to the advice and consent of the mayor and council.

The board members shall submit a monthly financial report to the mayor and council, which report shall be submitted not later than one (1) week prior to the regular monthly meeting of council.

Sec. 4-3-6 Budget.

The board members shall submit to the mayor and council a proper budget for the ensuing year by October 1st of each year. The budget may not be acted upon by the board members until it is approved by the mayor and council.
