CHAPTER 3

Street System Plan

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Sec. 6-3-1 System shown on map.

There is hereby established an official system of street names in the City as shown on the map entitled Wrens Street Numbering System dated March 1969, as produced by the planning commission, a copy of which is incorporated into and made part of this chapter. A copy of said shall be filed in the office of the City Clerk.

Sec. 6-3-2 Changes of names.

Names of streets in the City shall remain as shown on the map unless officially changed by specific ordinance.

Sec. 6-3-3 New streets.

No new streets shall be accepted by the City nor shall municipal improvements be made thereon until such streets have been named; if they are extensions of existing streets, the existing names shall be continued; and if not extensions, names recorded shall not duplicate or closely approximate street names already assigned.

Secs. 6-3-4 through 6-3-10 reserved.

Sec. 6-3-11 Uniform numbering system.

A uniform system of numbering properties and principal buildings, as shown on the map identified by the title Wrens Street Numbering System is hereby adopted for use in the City. This map and all explanatory matters thereon, are hereby incorporated into and made a part of this chapter.

Sec. 6-3-12 Assignment of numbers.

- a. All properties or parcels of land within the corporate limits of Wrens shall hereafter be identified by reference to the uniform numbering system adopted herein.
- b. A separate number shall be assigned for each 20 feet of frontage in congested business areas and each 50 feet of frontage in other areas.

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- c. Each house or building shall bear the number assigned to the frontage on which the front entrance is located. In case a building is occupied by more than one business or family dwelling unit, each separate front entrance of such principal building shall bear a separate number.
- d. Numerals indicating the official numbers for each house or building shall be posted in a manner as to be visible from the street on which the property is located. Such numerals may be obtained from the City Clerk at cost or from private sources.

Sec. 6-3-13 Administration.

- a. The City Clerk shall be responsible for maintaining the numbering system, but the planning commission or other designated authority shall approve the system in new subdivisions. In the performance of this responsibility the commission or authority shall be guided by the provisions of Section 6-3-12 of this chapter.
- b. The Clerk shall keep a record of all numbers assigned under this chapter.
- c. The City Clerk shall issue to any property owner in the City, upon request and at cost, a set of numerals for each building or separate front entrance to such building. In doing so, the Clerk shall issue only numerals for the number assigned to such building under the provisions of this chapter. Provided however, that the Clerk may issue additional numerals in accord with the official numbering system whenever a property has been subdivided, a new front entrance opened, or undue hardship has been worked on any property owner.

Sec. 6-3-14 Penalties.

Violation of this chapter shall, upon conviction, be punished by a fine of five dollars (\$5.00). Each separate day such violation is continued shall constitute a separate offense.
